UCPath - UC's new system for payroll, benefits and personnel services - goes live this month across UC Davis, UC Davis Health, and the Division of Agricultural and Natural Resources.

Here are the steps that all employees - academic, staff, and student - need to take to transition into the new system starting on September 27, 2019:

Enroll in Duo, a multifactor authentication system

It helps to protect the security of your data and is required for login to the UCPath Online portal. Duo can be used easily with a smartphone, a non-smart phone, a landline or a hard token. See <u>https://movetoduo.ucdavis.edu/</u>

Sign into UCPath Online



Once you have signed up for Duo, sign into UCPath Online at https://ucpath.universityofcalifornia.edu beginning September 27, 2019 using your computer, smartphone or tablet to verify and update your personal profile information, review your benefits and, if necessary, update your tax withholding.

Enroll in Direct Deposit

If you weren't previously on Direct Deposit, sign up for it in UCPath Online to avoid mail delays in receiving paper paychecks. Paychecks can no longer be picked up locally - they are mailed from an out-of-state service center and may take five or more business days to reach your home address on file.

If you wish, you can now elect to split your pay in direct deposit between two or three accounts

W-2

Opt-in to receiving your W-2 electronically in UCPath. Even if you've opted-in previously to receive your W-2 electronically in AYSO, you may need to opt-in in UCPath to receive your W-2 electronically for fall 2019 pay and future pay periods. For 2019, you will have two W-2 forms: one from AYSO for the winter, spring and summer that came from PPS and one from UCPath for fall 2019 and thereafter.

Review your first pay statements!

Carefully review your first pay statement in October 2019 and notify your department immediately if anything is wrong. Earnings statements starting in October 2019 and going forward will be viewable in UCPath Online.

Open Enrollment

Open Enrollment will take place in UCPath later this fall. Online changes to enrollment elections will occur in UCPath, not AYSO.
