- Department of Neurology Physiology and Behavior, College of Biological Sciences and Department of Neurology, School of Medicine
- Achieved tenure in July 2020
- Dr. Wilsaan Joiner's research group conducts translational research in healthy individuals and clinical conditions such as Schizophrenia, Alzheimer's Disease, and patients with upper limb differences. He obtained his PhD in Biomedical Engineering from the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine, and was a postdoctoral fellow at Harvard University and the National Eye Institute. His current research is funded by several grants from NASA, the Alzheimer's Association, National Science Foundation and the National Institutes of Health.
