I am pleased to announce that the Professional Development Program will provide awards for the 2026-2027 academic year. The application instructions and cover sheet are posted on the Vice Provost-Academic Affairs web site at https://academicaffairs.ucdavis.edu/uc-and-campus-awards.

This competitive program provides funding to enable Unit 18 members to engage in professional development activities that will enhance their effectiveness in their current position. Category A awards include travel to professional meetings during April 2026 – March 2027.
