- Seed Grants for International Activities
 - \$5000-10000
 - matched
 - Applications due in December
- Grants for Advancing Sustainable Development Goals
 - \$7500
 - Collaboration with the Office of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion and the Office of Sustainability
 - Applications due in January



Awards for international and global engagement in research, teaching and service

- Chancellor's Award for International Activities
- Award for Excellence in the Teaching of Study Abroad
- Calls will open in November and due in January
