Seed Grants for International Activities

Global Affairs partners with UC Davis schools and colleges to offer grants of up to \$20,000 to support innovative international research, spur future collaborations and stimulate external funding. To date, over \$2.7 million in seed funding has led to over \$50 million in external grants.

Grants for Advancing the UN Sustainable Development Goals

Co-sponsored by Global Affairs, Sustainability, Grand Challenges and Diversity, Equity and Inclusion, these team-focused grants of up to \$7,500 fund locally or globally executed, but internationally oriented, multi-disciplinary activities that highlight and enhance UC Davis' connections to the UN Sustainable Development Goals.

Supporting Engagement with the SDGs

Global Affairs offers a variety of resources to support faculty engagement with the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Global Affairs can facilitate connections with international networks and partners that are focused on the SDGs, and have an interest in collaborating on these goals.

In 2021, UC Davis Global Affairs, Sustainability, and the Office of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion completed the first campus Voluntary University Review (VUR) on the UN SDGs. The final report is available online. The VUR includes a section on each of the 17 SDGs, summarizing available information from across campus on UC Davis research, teaching, service and operations. The VUR is a resource for faculty, staff and students to discover UC Davis initiatives and programs that contribute to the SDGs.
